SGH domestic Field Work (Global Health group)

① Nagasaki University Medical School (Comprehensive Community Care)



On Tuesday, August 1st, 64 students visited Nagasaki University's medical school and joined a lecture by Dr. Kouji Nagata. They had a discussion about medical jobs. Later, they experienced a stomach echo examination and auscultation. It was a valuable experience for the students. Then they learned about the history of Nagasaki's medical background being different from other areas types of medical care, medical information is increasing rapidly, and that general medical care is not just in a hospital but also concerned with an entire region.





② Nagasaki University Tropical Disease Research Center

On Tuesday, August 1st, 25 students visited the Nagasaki University Tropical Disease Research Institute. They were taught "Why become scientists?" and learned about the careers of three teachers. Next, Associated Professor Yoshinao Kubo (a specialist of viruses), Assistant Professor Toshihiko Sahara (a specialist of mosquitoes), and Assistant Professor Kentaro Kato (a specialist of worms) separated into three groups. The professors answered questions by students about experimentation content and ways how to do experiments. So, the student's eagerness to carry out experiments was increased. At the tropical medicine museum, they were explained the details of viral specimens, worm viruses, disease carrying insects, dangerous animals and so on. And they watched a video about mosquitoes in which they learned about mosquito ecosystems. Also, they could hear about the safety and requirements BSL (Bio Safety Level-4).
