Visiting the Faculty of Global Humanities - Idea Exchange

On Monday, May 8th, eight students from the peace division and six students from the water division visited the Nagasaki University Faculty of Global Humanities and Social Sciences to do an idea exchange with Dr. Morikawa. At first Dr. Morikawa explained how to study and understand international relations in South East Asia. He gave us a chance to think about the definition of ‘peace’. After that he answered questions from students and gave advice. “Probably the cause of struggle is due to poverty” was one answer he provided. “Choose one case in the past and gather a position or interest. We can find factors about poverty”. The students had some impressions like “I learned something that I had never known before about how to research properly”, “I checked that it wasn’t a misdirection of our ideas”, and “I want to deepen our research further”.
