## 8 How to make Tambo Art

### (1) Creating designs

- ①Ask for design ideas using a Questionnaire created by members.
- ②Consider design appearance.
- ③Photograph the design and put on grid paper.  
(1/100 picture, Secure at lowest 50cm)
- ④Write the coordinate points on the design of the grid paper.
- ⑤Laminate grid paper.

### (2) Rice planting method of Tambo Art

- ①Stand a 180cm Support up 5m intervals.
- ②Stand a 75cm coordinate point up.
- ③Connect the 75cm Support with a string.
- ④Plant “hinohikari” around “midorikome”
